## What is CCaBSS

CCaBSS has been developed to meet the needs of families in the catchment area as defined by Child Safety Services. The aim is to build strength and resilience in families and provide opportunities and support to:

- Improve the wellbeing and safety of children, young people and their families.
- Build the capacity of families to care for and protect their children
- Prevent entry or re-entry to the statutory child protection system.

### Referrals should meet the following criteria:

- There is a child/children under 18 living in the home.
- The family would benefit from access to family support, intervention and/or referral to specialist support service.
- The child/children are not currently under a child protection order.
- The family consents to the referral.
- Families may also self-refer (who meet the above criteria).

## What can it offer

### Counselling

- Counselling and in home support (as appropriate).
- Groups tailored to meet participants needs.
- Address issues of family of origin, child abuse, behavioural problems & relationships issues.
- Case plan meetings with families and other agencies.
- This is a professional confidential service. We promote respect and support for those working through immediate and long term issues.

### Budgeting

- Identify strategies to minimize financial stress.
- Help identify and set up systems to save money.
- Advocate to creditors regarding payment plans.

## What is FaRSS

FaRSS is a secondary family support service aimed at reducing harm or risk of harm to children and young people, prevent crises or problems within families from arising or escalating and stabilise or maintain family wellbeing.

- Improve the wellbeing and safety of children, young people and their families.
- Build the capacity of families to care for and protect their children
- Provide linkages to local universal support services/community groups to enable families to access the resources to build their capacity to solve problems and make positive choices and changes.
- Prevent entry or re-entry to the statutory child protection system.
